Three Day ITINERARY

Day One – Kayak the Lakes of Killarney

Killarney is famed for its beautiful lakes, which have lured travellers to their waters for thousands of years. Accompanied by a local guide, you can choose from a number of different kayak trips on the lakes of Killarney ranging in duration from two hours to seven hours.

Day Two – Historical Sites

Killarney's many historical sites are rich in variety and culture. From early monastic settlements to the stately homes and gardens such as Muckross House and Killarney House. Travel through Irish history with a visit to the 4000-year-old-copper mines at Ross Island, the ancient monasteries at Aghadoe, Innisfallen Island and Muckross, the iconic Ross Castle representing the age of the Irish Chieftains, while Muckross House and Killarney House provide a glimpse into the era of the ascendancy.

Day Three – Beer Tasting

After two full days exploring Killarney, its time to relax and enjoy a sampling of Killarney's finest craft beers. Killarney Brewery offer tours of their brewery where you can meet the brewers, sample their produce and enjoy their unique take on Killarney and its folklore. If beer is not your thing, then the equally interesting Irish Whiskey Experience offer a simple introduction into the rich world of Irish whiskey – the history, the process and a comparative tasting of whiskies to help refine your pallet.
